




Engineering issues in PSM


- Integrate Project sustainability within the project development process
- Include client objective
- Stakeholder involvment & civil society
 - What is the right community?
- Goal selection
- Resilience planning
 - Design for 50 years to resist to changes in climate conditions



How to Monitor/report / verify?

- 1. Find/ select appropriate parameters & certification matching local conditions
 - Planning/Design/Construction/Operation/End of life
- 2. Report: Select the right platform to share information with the stakeholders
 - 3. Verfify: Need for a third party to validate and control
 - NGO / Local citizen association





The ABC for Sustainable cities

- UNEP and FIDIC announced the publication of the international glossary on sustainable cities for COP21. Its goal is to enhance synergies between leading international organizations on sustainability (UNEP, UN-Habitat, ICLEI, C40, ISO, ITU, CEN, CENELEC ETSI).

- The right project with holistic approach included in a program
- The right community
- The right technology (BIM?)
- The right contracting platform (ITER)
- The right Dispute Board Mechanism (ITER)

How can we define a continuous approach?

- Keep enlarging the involvement of the community
 - Use of reporting platform to share content
 - Keep governance open to new participants
- Use BIM and multicontracting to allow interface management
 - innovation between projects
 - Allow variation
 - Include new technology
- Implement permanent Dispute Boards
- Keep a dynamic finance model and risk sharing option
